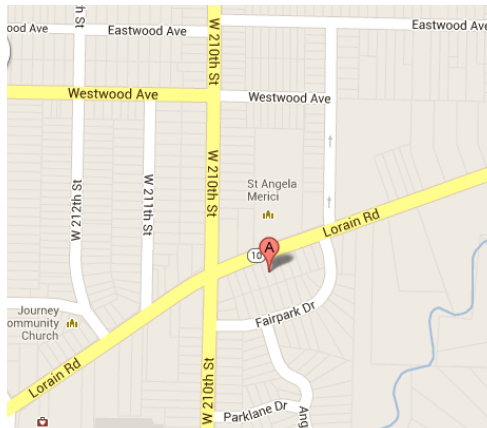


Your first appointment is very important. We need to learn about you and you need to feel comfortable with us. Since it is critical for us to have an accurate medical and dental history, please bring a complete list of any medications that you are taking and health related issues that you may have. Many conditions and medications can have an effect on your mouth.

We will then examine the areas of your mouth that are of concern. If necessary, appropriate x-rays will be taken to aid us in diagnosis. After gathering this information, we will discuss your condition with you and suggest the most effective treatment to achieve dental health.

Did you know that people with periodontal disease are four times more likely to be affected with heart disease and strokes than people who don't? Treating periodontal problems is one of the most important things you can do for yourself and your family. We take it seriously, and so should you.

We ask that the fee for the initial visit be paid in full at that time, whether you have dental insurance or not. Once a treatment plan is decided upon, for those who have dental insurance, we will work with you and your carrier to maximize your benefits. For those who have limited or no dental coverage, our Treatment Coordinator will discuss a variety of payment options. Our goal is not to let expense prevent you from the quality of care you desire and need.
